

"Mobilities" DiSSGeA Development Project Visiting Scholars Grant 2025 CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

In the framework of the "Mobilities: A transdisciplinary framework for research, international teaching and public engagement in the Humanities" Department Development Project (PSD 2023-2027), the DiSSGeA (Department of Historical and Geographic Sciences and the Ancient World; hereinafter referred to as "the Department") has launched a Call for Applications for Visiting Scholars Grants for the year 2025. The initiative provides the assignment of positions as Visiting Scholars to professors, researchers, and early career scholars (postdoctoral researchers, lectures, etc.) from international universities or research centres.

Art. 1 – ELIGIBILITY

The present call is addressed to professors, researchers, and early career scholars affiliated to European and non-European universities and research centres. Applicants must spend a period of approximately one (1) month at the Department and its "Mobility & Humanities" Centre for Advanced Studies (hereinafter referred to as "MOHU"), from October 1st, 2025 through June 31st, 2026. The 2024 call grant beneficiaries cannot apply for the 2025 call.

Art. 2 – IMPLEMENTATION OF ACTIVITIES

During their stay at the University of Padua (hereinafter referred to as "the University"), the Visiting Scholars must contribute to the life of the MOHU by presenting their mobility-based research, taking part in the "Mobility and Humanities" seminar series or giving a didactic seminar at the Degree Courses held at Dissgea. During their stay, the Visiting Scholars will have the opportunity to work on their own research and to exchange ideas with MOHU members. The Department shall grant the Visiting Scholars the use of:

- its spaces, libraries (including off-site electronic resource access, subject to publishers' restrictions), laboratories, instruments, and any other facility necessary to fulfil the planned activities
 - UNIPD login and e-mail account at the University to access Unipd services
 - attendance at public lectures and seminars

Art. 3 – FUNDING

The Visiting Scholarship will be funded by the Department through the Department Development

For the above-mentioned stay and activities, the Department will provide a total net amount of \in 2.500 for each of the two projects funded. To this amount, the Department shall apply tax contributions in accordance with current legislation. If the non-resident Visiting Scholar decides to apply an existing Convention for the avoidance of double taxation between Italy and his/her country of residence, he/she will only pay taxes there. If not, the University will need to charge extra tax contributions in Italy (including Italian social security taxes).

The Department shall also provide insurance coverage for accidents and civil liability in accordance with the conditions stated in the policies taken out by the University.

Art. 4 – SUBMISSION

Applications must be submitted by professors, researchers and early career scholars of European and non-European universities and research centres, using the provided **Google Form**, together with:

- Curriculum Vitae
- List of academic publications
- Detailed programme of planned activities (see the Application Form, Section C)
- A copy of Passport (or ID Card, for EU citizens only)
- Person of reference at the Department
- Motivation letter, including future cooperation opportunities

THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION IS APRIL 15TH, 2025 AT 1:00 PM (CET).

Applications must be submitted by e- mail to <u>research.dissgea@unipd.it</u> with the subject "Mobilities Visiting Scholarship". Incomplete or incorrect applications will be excluded from the selection procedure.

Art. 5 – SELECTION PROCEDURE

Applications will be assessed by a Selection Committee appointed by the Department's Scientific Committee, who will review the proposals. Assignment will be awarded on merit ranking criteria.

The results of the selection procedure will be communicated to successful candidates no later than May 15th. Selected candidates must communicate their <u>formal acceptance no later than June 15th.</u> Those who do not respect this deadline will be excluded from the selection procedure.

In case of renouncement of one or two selected Visiting Scholars, suitable candidates will be contacted according to ranking.
